JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend each performance of SHOCKHEADED PETER (see calendar here: http://companyone.org/event-calendar/)
- Arrive 2 hours before show time to organize and prep lobby, as well as clean up during post performance
- Operate concessions and lobby bookstore during each performance
- Oversee setup/breakdown of audience surveys
- Maintain nightly paperwork
- Serve as the face of Company One during performances
- Participate in Load-In & Load-Out, as well as attendance at a dress rehearsal during tech week
- Attend orientation and training, at times to be determined between you and the Production Manager.

REQUIREMENTS

A love of theatre and previous experience in customer service, management and/or administration required. Experience in theatre a plus.

Candidates from diverse backgrounds and/or traditionally under-represented groups are strongly urged to apply.

Pay is \$9/hr.
