JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Design the scenery & properties for the production within the parameters of the budget (note: this position is listed as "Associate" as the scenic design involved in this production will be minimal, and some already exists from the initial workshop production which the Director may want to maintain.)
- Obtain all necessary properties for the production by borrowing, building, or purchasing properties.
- Attend all scheduled production meetings, designer runs, technical & dress rehearsals, and load-in and load-out dates
- Work with the stage management team to create and maintain a complete properties list.
- Read all rehearsal reports, and provide rehearsal props as needed throughout the rehearsal process, and for any scheduled photo or video shoots
- Read all performance reports, and perform properties maintenance/replenishment as needed during the production run
- Find and arrange for a location to do all necessary properties construction.
- Collaborate with the director and other designers to achieve the best product and highest quality possible

REQUIREMENTS

Previous experience in theatre required. Candidates from diverse backgrounds and/or traditionally underrepresented groups are strongly encouraged to apply. Boston-based candidates only.
