Position: C1 Street Team Program Director

<u>Description</u>: Company One Theatre seeks an ambitious, self-motivated individual to lead and shape the C1 Street Team, a community organizing program focused on connecting Boston's young adult population with each other and the city through the arts.

Be part of Company One Theatre's artistic collaborative and provide a strong voice that will help grow C1 audiences and shape the future of the organization. The Street Team Program Director reports directly to the Managing Director and works closely with the Marketing and Dramaturgy Departments, as well the entire C1 staff. This is an exempt, approximately 20-30 hour/week position and is responsible for:

- Broadening and deepening Company One Theatre's engagement with Boston's 15-24 year old population
- Managing the day to day operation of the program, including supervising three part-time Street Team Members, and a group of Associate Members
- Identifying and managing community partnerships
- Coordinating involvement in community events
- Managing Team staffing and audience interaction for production performances
- Developing and Managing program outcomes and evaluation
- Attending weekly staff meetings

Pay: \$18,000 salary, plus a monthly T pass

#### **Qualifications:**

- A self-starter, who can work both independently and collaboratively
- Experience with community organizing a plus
- Experience with developing measurable outcomes a plus
- Management experience a plus
- College degree is preferred, but not required
- Excellent interpersonal skills including working with the public
- Comfortable with non-traditional management and work structures
- Comfort with Adobe Creative Suite desired
- Passion for Company One's mission, audience and programming a must

The C1 Street Team is a group of community organizers that embody our mission to eliminate Boston's social divides that occur along racial, cultural, economic and geographic lines.
