JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Design and construct or obtain the costumes & makeup for the production within the parameters of the budget
- Collaborate with the director and other designers to achieve the best product and highest quality possible
- Arrange for a location to do all necessary costume construction
- Attend all scheduled production meetings and designer runs
- Attend all technical and dress rehearsals
- Read all performance reports distributed during the run of the production and maintain availability to communicate regarding any issues raised

Production meetings will begin in mid-February; Rehearsals March – April; Performances April 20 – May 14.

REQUIREMENTS

Previous experience in costume design for theatre preferred. Experience in fashion a plus.

Candidates from diverse backgrounds and/or traditionally under-represented groups are strongly encouraged to apply.

Boston-based candidates highly preferred, as we are unable to provide travel compensation or housing. This is a per-show position and is paid by stipend.
