### JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Design lighting for the production within the parameters of the budget
- Collaborate with the director and other designers to achieve the best product and highest quality possible
- Work with the technical director to budget and source equipment
- Program all lighting cues & provide a cue list to the production stage manager
- Attend all scheduled production meetings and designer runs
- Attend all technical and dress rehearsals

First meeting & read through in March. Production meetings will begin in May; Rehearsals June – July; Performances July 17 – August 15.

### REQUIREMENTS

Previous experience in professional lighting design for theatre required. MFA is a plus.

Candidates from diverse backgrounds and/or traditionally under-represented groups are strongly encouraged to apply.

Boston-based candidates highly preferred, as we are unable to provide travel compensation or housing. This is a per-show position and is paid by stipend.
