Position: Education Associate

<u>Description:</u> Company One Theatre (C1) seeks a talented and self-motivated individual to significantly support the organization's education department. Be part of Company One Theatre's successful artistic collective and provide a strong voice that will help grow C1's education efforts and shape the future of the organization. This is a part-time salaried position, which includes (but is not limited to) the following responsibilities:

- Attending Weekly Department/Staff Meetings (Monday nights), and participating as a full member in the staff collective that runs the company
- Working six hours in the C1 offices during the work-week
- Maintaining the Education portions of the C1 calendar and website, and creating material for the website, blog, brochures, newsletters, packets, and grants
- · Developing education packets for productions and generating reports for grant submissions/updates
- Performing evaluations and assessments for the In-School, Apprentice, and Professional Development for Actors program
- Representing the Education department at C1 Events
- Serving as a producer-on-duty at 1 performance per week of each C1 production
- · Attending monthly High School Working Group meetings and bi-weekly Boston School Committee Meetings
- Performing twice quarterly observations of in-school classrooms
- Planning and leading quarterly professional development sessions for Teaching Artists and supporting Teaching Artists through feedback and integration of best practices
- · Substitute teaching in classrooms, when necessary, for Company One Theatre Teaching Artists.
- Managing the application process for school year and summer employment programs, and developing program schedules/curriculum for school year and summer student employees
- Supervising school year and summer student employees/implement curriculum
- Recording classes and performances, and disseminating, collecting, and tracking student and student employee evaluations
- · Maintaining databases as necessary

Position is an average of 20 hours/week, fluctuating based on the time of year. Salary is \$20,000/year.

Qualifications:

- BA or BFA in Theatre, Education or Child Development preferred
- Must be motivated by our mission and vision
- Must be willing to embrace a demanding environment where different hats are worn on a regular basis
- Should be able to use a PC and Microsoft Office Suite, copier, fax
- · Spanish fluency, experience in multiple performing arts disciplines, and K-12 teaching certification preferred, but not required
