Company One Theatre seeks candidates for the position of ASSISTANT STAGE MANAGER / WARDROBE SUPERVISOR for their production VIETGONE by Qui Nguyen (*She Kills Monsters*), to be produced at the Boston Center for the Arts, April 27 – May 25, 2019.

The ASM/Wardrobe Supervisor will attend the first full cast & staff meeting and read through on February 19, and re-join rehearsals beginning April 2. Tech will begin April 20, with opening April 27. Performances run through May 25, Wednesday through Saturday nights, Sunday matinees, and select educational and Saturday matinees. All rehearsals & meetings are weeknights and weekend days.

Responsibilities include supporting the stage management team during rehearsals and performances, attending costume fittings as needed, assisting with costumes load-in/load-out, maintaining dressing rooms, dressing performers before and during performances, and performing costume maintenance and laundering/dry cleaning during tech and the performance run.

REQUIREMENTS

Previous experience in costumes, wardrobe, and/or assistant stage management. Candidates from diverse backgrounds and/or traditionally under-represented groups are strongly encouraged to apply. Boston-based candidates or those who have their own housing/transportation in the Boston area only.
