



COMPANY ONE THEATRE: MASTER ELECTRICIAN

Company One Theatre seeks candidates for the position of Master Electrician for the National New Play Network's rolling world premiere of WOLF PLAY by Hansol Jung. The production will be directed by Summer L. Williams, produced in partnership with the Boston Public Library, and performances will be held at Rabb Hall at the BPL.

Lighting load-in, hang, and focus will be between January 17-24 between 10am-10pm. Exact schedule TBD. Tech is from January 25 – February 1, first preview is on January 30, and load-out on March 1. The production runs January 30 - February 29, performances Wednesday - Saturday nights, and Saturday & Sunday matinees.

JOB DESCRIPTION

- Work with the production manager to prepare a rental request from the lighting plot
- Assist in the rental/purchase of any necessary lighting or SFX materials
- Scheduling electricians to work calls as needed, within the scope of the budget set by the Production Manager
- Lead a team of electricians in hanging and cabling the lighting plot
- Work with the Lighting Designer to focus the lighting plot and assist with programming cues
- Setting up tech tables prior to tech and striking them prior to opening
- Assisting Stage Management with installation of running lights and taping any cables affecting onstage safety
- Maintaining availability during the performance run to address any urgent lighting issues that cannot be addressed by Stage Management
- Striking all lighting and SFX equipment at the end of the run
- Assisting with rental returns if necessary

REQUIREMENTS

Previous experience as a Master Electrician in theatre required. Experience driving a genie lift a plus. Candidates from diverse backgrounds and/or traditionally under-represented groups are strongly encouraged to apply. Boston-based candidates only.
